


Q1 How often do you use our park?




#	COMMENT

3	The north area (on the right next to the brick wall) looks good with the zero scape. The north curve bed needs to be cleaned out redularly. Thankfully it has water tolerant plants. Additional plants were transplanted the front beds on Marsh lane during the renovation of the wall project in 2022. The south area needs some attention. I dont think the flower bed and grass area is getting watered regularly. Those areas do not have their own sprinkler system owned by the HOA. The areas are graciously watered by homeowner sprinkler systems which come under the sidewalk. There used to be metal edging around the plants in the bed going up to the sidewalk. It was removed several years ago and now is bare dirt with no grass around it and the HOA bench.





1	#3. it depends on what the area of concern is. we donated 1k to the front wall just after moving in. that was a worthy cause. #4. if my health allows, i would be happy to volunteer on projects. However, that can't happen for at least a year as i just had 9 disks in my back fused and my husband had a stroke in 2020 and is not capable of manual labor. ease up the requirements on the landscaping modification forms. my landscaping might not still look like it does if i didn't have to jump through hoops to add some red yucca plants along the front of my house and get rid of the remaining shrubs that didn't die during the big freeze before i moved in.
2	Survey actual renters not the landlord to see if they are on board in maintaining property and seasonal access to tennis courts or events.
3	The handrail on the park steps should be moved to one side or the other. It is very difficult for anyone with a walker, a baby stroller, even a large cooler, or a person walking with a toddler's hand or walking the dog by their side to walk up the narrow area. For such a small set of stairs, handrails should be on the side.
4	Asking for additional funds as our HOA dues continue to rise drastically is not a good idea at the current time.
5	Everything looks in decent enough shape to me. I would rather have us save money in case something was absolutely necessary or something happened (like if the fence fell down, or tennis net completely broke, then have money to fix it).
6	I am nearly 82 years old, a widow on a tight budget. I cannot physically do any of the things listed above. I cannot give to every need, or whim people with plenty of money want to do then expect a donation. I know not everything is a whim and many things are needed. We need a Treasurer who is hands on and doesn't leave everything to Insight. We need the Treasurer to go over the financials at every meeting. I get tired of hearing about the 8 people who donated to this or that. It's constantly shoved down our throats. I also get tired of "if you can't donate, you don't need to live here," The HOA and residents who have moved in here need to understand that a lot of longtime residents are on a fixed income. Thank you, Mary, for heading up this committee and the work you do. This is a wonderful community and place to live.
7	To the Board, for at least the next couple of years, the landscaping budget need to increase to get caught up on tree maintenance. Also to the Board, pay attention to the reserve study --money needs to be spent on the courts before the damage is greater.
8	WE SHOULD INCREASE OUR DUES TO \$1,200 PER YEAR PER ADDRESS.
9	Actually, all residents pay \$600 every January to the Main which I believe is \$106,200 a year. so if there are reputable bids on any work to be done that should help with the budget.
